



Doreatha Fields

May 26, 1947 - May 2, 2017

After a protracted battle with a stroke, Doreatha Fields died on May 2, 2017 at Creekside Living Assistant Nursing Home in Reidsville, NC at the age of 70. She leaves behind her son, John Fields, sisters, Hattie Mae Fields-Young, Anna Fields-Talbert; and her brother, Dr. Richard Fields.
