Mr. Joseph F. Douthit, Jr., age seventy-eight, was born to the late Louise Abbott Douthit and Joseph F. Douthit, Sr., on November 27, 1943. He departed this life on Wednesday, November 9, 2022, at Country Side Manor Healthcare Facility in Stokesdale, North Carolina following an extended period of
