Mrs. Ollie Thomas, 100, of 1205 Midway School Road, Winston-Salem, NC, transitioned from labor to reward Thursday, December 31, 2020 after an extended period of illness. She was born April 27, 1920 in Davidson County to the late Nettie Eller Thomas and James Franklin Thomas. Educated in the Davidson County School System, she worked for over 40 years as a domestic worker with the White family, and was a foster parent for many years.

As a lifetime member of the Righteous Church of God, Midway NC, she committed to the Lord at an early age under the leadership of Bishop James Williford. Mother Ollie as she was affectionately known, served faithfully and passionately in several capacities including President of the Pastor's Aide, Missions, and Kitchen Committee. Also, she had a gift in fundraising for the church and the church treasurer.

Ollie utilized her musical gifts in organizing the "Gospel Travelers." She was well known for training the voices of many young people in the community, playing the piano, and making her washboard sing in the corner of the church. It was her gift to lead praise and worship, setting the atmosphere for Sunday morning worship. Her favorite hymn was, "A Charge to Keep I Have."

Ollie was an avid traveler, organizing numerous bus trips across the states, no grass grew under her feet. She was known for her sweet potato pies, and the

neighborhood candy store for many years. She was the ultimate willing worker and a premiere example of good works, who will be missed by her family, church family, and the Midway Community.

Ollie was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Mack William Tuttle; sisters, Sallie Shoaf Thomas and Pearl Wagner; and brothers, Robbie C. Thomas, John Henry Thomas, Rev. Golden Thomas, and Bernie Lee Thomas.

She is survived by a host of nieces and nephews; devoted family Cherry, Ron, Teresa, and Maurice (The White Family); cousins, other relatives, and friends.
